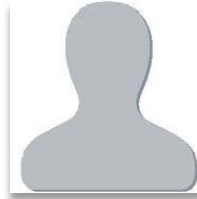

CONSTITUTION AND BY LAWS OF THE PHILIPPINE SOCIETY OF ANIMAL SCIENCE

PREAMBLE

We, the members of the Philippine Society of Animal Science, imploring the aid of Divine Providence in order to establish an association that shall foster our ideals, enhance the development of animal industry, promote our general welfare, integrate the various professions and occupations engaged in livestock, poultry, domestic and wild animals research instruction, extension, and production including its supportive services, hereby ordain and promulgate this Constitution.

ARTICLE I

NAME, SEAL, BANNER and DOMICILE

- Section 1. The association shall be known as the Philippine Society of Animal Science or PSAS for short.
- Section 2. The permanent headquarters shall be at the University of the Philippines Los Baños. The official address shall be: Philippine Society of Animal Science, UPLB, College, Laguna.
- Section 3. The seal of the Society shall be a microscope drawn within a double circle, outside the circle shall be a carabao head at the bottom, cattle at the left, chicken at the upper top center and pig at the right facing the reader, circum- scribed by a double circle, outside this circle shall be inscribed "Philippine Society of Animal Science 1963", which shall be encircled by a light circle and a heavy circle.
- Section 4. The flag of the Society shall be three feet by five feet, the color of which shall be gray, in the middle of which shall be yellow, the lettering circles and picture in dark green.

ARTICLE III

OBJECTIVES

- Section 1. The objectives of the Society shall be to:
- a. Provide opportunities for members to meet and exchange information, ideas and experiences in the veterinary and animal sciences.
 - b. Define the more important problems limiting animal productivity and encourage investigations aimed at their solution.
 - c. Promote, foster, and encourage the application of improved methods of animal production and health emanating from both research and practical experience.
 - d. Assist in the training of future leaders in the field of animal science and veterinary medicine.
 - e. Correspond and coordinate with local or foreign societies with similar objectives.
 - f. Publish a technical journal to be known as Philippine Journal of Veterinary and Animal Sciences. (PJVAS).
 - g. Publish a magazine which shall be known as PSAS Dispatch.
 - h. Extend assistance to any member towards the attainment of the Society's objectives.

- i. Give recognition to persons and/or organizations who have worked and contributed to animal science or veterinary medicine

**ARTICLE III
MEMBERSHIP and FEES**

Section 1. Eligibility

All persons irrespective of nationality, engaged or previously engaged in research, teaching or extension in animal health and production, or those engaged or previously engaged in raising of livestock and poultry including processing of products resulting therefrom or those engaged or previously engaged in the supportive services to livestock and poultry, shall be eligible for membership.

Section 2. The following shall be the kinds of membership:

- a. Charter member - member who originally organized the Society. All charter members shall be considered life members.
- b. Life member - any member after paying P1,000.00 or any amount determined by the council.
- c. Regular member - any eligible person after recommendation of two members and after payment of membership due shall be registered as regular member.
- d. Honorary member - the Society may nominate to honorary membership any person who has achieved distinction in research, teaching, extension, or production in the field of veterinary or animal science or its supportive services.
- e. Sustaining member - any organization or institution, club or society engaged in the field of animal or veterinary science or their supportive services shall be eligible for membership.

Section 3. Fees

- a. Regular membership fee - an amount of one hundred pesos (100.00) or as determined by the Council shall be required to those whose membership applications are approved. However, the amount may be increased by the Council as it deems necessary.
- b. Annual fee - each member shall pay an annual fee of one hundred pesos (100.00) not later than the last day of January of each year, provided that the amount may be increased by the Council depending on the need.
- c. Life membership - a fee of one thousand pesos (1,000.00) or as determined by the Council shall be collected for life membership.

Section 4. Privileges of members - all members of the Society shall be entitled to attend the Annual Convention or any general meeting with the right to vote, to present motions, suggestions or resolutions for consideration, to be nominated to office, to submit papers for publication, to receive all publications, news, bulletin, which the society may publish from time to time.

Section 5. Obligation of members - members shall be obliged to participate in national convention, uphold and defend this Constitution and By-Laws, pay the dues regularly and punctually and help in the building of a strong, cohesive, dynamic, and relevant organization.

Section 6. Forfeiture of membership - membership in the Society shall be automatically terminated after two consecutive years in arrears. Upon payment of dues, the members shall be considered reinstated. Members who are convicted of any crime involving moral turpitude and unprofessional conduct shall automatically lose membership.

**ARTICLE IV
OFFICERS, TENURE of OFFICE and DUTIES**

Section 1. Officers - the Officers of the Society (Council Members) shall be the following:

President	Five Council Members
Vice-President and President Elect	Immediate Past-President
Secretary	Editor of the Philippine Journal of Veterinary and Animal Sciences (PJVAS)
Auditor	Editor of PSAS Dispatch

Section 2. Terms of Office

The President, Vice-President and President Elect, Secretary, Treasurer, Auditor, the 5 Council Members and the Immediate Past President shall serve for one year or until their successors shall have been chosen.

The PSAS Dispatch and PJVAS Editors shall be ex-officio members. The former shall serve for one year and the latter, 3 years.

Section 3. Powers and Duties - The following shall be the powers and duties of the officers:

- a. President
 1. Preside over all meetings. However, if he decides to participate actively in the discussion, he may delegate this to any member.
 2. Approve disbursement based on the budget.
 3. Countersign checks for payments.
 4. Countersign withdrawals from depositories.
 5. Accept donations, grants, requests, etc. in behalf of the association and turn them over to the treasurer.
 6. Create committees and appoint members thereof.
 7. Call emergency meetings from time to time as the need arises.
 8. Plan the activities of the Society.
 9. Prepare a budget of the Society and have it approved by the Council.
 10. Be responsible to all the members for the general performance of the Society during his incumbency.
 11. Prepare and deliver a written terminal report to the assembly.

12. Represent the Society in any meeting when the association should be represented.

b. Vice-President and President Elect

1. Automatically becomes President one year after his election. However, he shall only take over normally after the National Convention. The position of Vice-President and President Elect shall alternate between a veterinarian and an animal science man.
2. Take over the functions of the President in case of long absence, resignation, incapacity or natural vacancy.
3. Prepare an outline of activities in the forth-coming year to be presented to the General Assembly during his inaugural speech.
4. Perform other duties as the President and the Council may designate.

c. Secretary

1. Keep an updated roll of members.
2. Prepare minutes of the General Assembly and Council meetings.
3. Issue notices of meetings.
4. Appraise the President and the Council of the status of the Society from time to time.
5. Maintain a Society scrapbook to contain pictures and captions of the major activities of the Society.
6. Receive and keep all property and documents of the Society and turn them over to his successor duly documented
7. Perform other duties the President may designate.

d. Treasurer

1. Receive the Society's money, donations, bequests, and grants.
2. Deposit the money of the Society in the bank duly authorized by the Council.
3. Disburse the funds of the Society upon approval of the President. However, the Treasurer may disburse funds, without prior approval of the President only on routinary expenses amounting to not more than two hundred pesos (200.00).
4. Prepare a financial statement periodically as determined by the Council or when so demanded by the Auditor.

e. Auditor

1. Countersign all cash receipts.
2. Note all turnover of property.

3. Note all documents of donation, bequests, etc.
4. See to it that expenses are reasonable and funds are available following the budget.
5. Pass on audit the financial statement of the Treasurer.

ARTICLE V ELECTION of OFFICERS

Section 1. Election of Council Members

Candidates for the offices of the Vice-President and President Elect, Secretary, Treasurer, Auditor and 5 Council Members shall be nominated during the annual meeting. Each nominee shall be asked to indicate his willingness to serve when elected.

Voting for each member of the Council, except for the office of President and Immediate Past-President, shall be by secret ballot which shall be scrutinized by three electoral board members appointed by the Council at the Annual General Meeting. A member in good standing cannot vote by proxy. A candidate for office shall direct that voting papers be destroyed immediately following the announcement of the officers elected.

Section 2. Appointment of Editorial Staff

The members of the Editorial Board of both PSAS Dispatch and PJVAS other than the Editors shall be appointed by the Council at its first meeting of the fiscal year. The associate editor shall automatically become the editor after the expiration of the editor's term.

ARTICLE VI CHAPTERS

Section 1. Formation

Should there be sufficient local support, the Society may establish in Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao. Each chapter shall elect its own officers. The activities of these Chapters shall be governed by the Constitution and By-laws of the Philippine Society of Animal Science.

Section 2. Allocation of Fees

Half of the membership and annual dues collected by the provincial and regional chapters shall be remitted to the Treasurer of the National Organization and half will be retained.

Section 3. Extension and Development Activities

It shall be the responsibility of the Chapters to conduct/sponsor seminars and local convention activities in their respective areas but the National Organization shall continue to be the venue for the reading and discussion of research papers annually.

Section 4. Reports

Chapters shall be required to report semi-annually to the National Organization

**ARTICLE VII
MEETINGS**

Section 1. Annual General Meetings

The Philippine Society of Animal Science shall hold an Annual Convention to be held at a time and place to be decided by the Council. Written notice shall be sent to all voting members by the Secretary at least 20 days before the date of the meeting. The quorum at any Annual General Meeting shall comprise not less than 25% of the total financial membership of the society

Section 2. Emergency General Meeting

The Society may convene an Emergency General Meeting of the organization at any time by giving at least 21 days notice by circular to all members and by advertisement. The quorum for any such Emergency General Meeting shall be the same as that of the Annual Convention.

Any fifteen (15) members of the Society may require the Council to convene an Emergency General Meeting by giving a written notice to the Secretary not less than 30 days prior to the suggested date for the meeting. Such notice must be signed by all 15 members stating the reasons for convening an Emergency General Meeting.

Section 3. Animal Science Council Meeting

The President, Vice-President and President Elect, Secretary, and Treasurer may convene meeting of the council at any time by giving at least 10 days notice in writing to all members of the Council. The Council shall be responsible for drawing up its own Rules of Procedure.

**ARTICLE VIII
FINANCE**

Section 1. Sources of Income

The income of the Philippine Society of Animal Science shall be derived from:

1. Membership fees
2. Annual fees
3. Donation in cash or in kind
4. Grants
5. Subscriptions
6. Convention fees
7. Sustaining membership fees
8. Others

Section 2. Annual Statement of Accounts

The Treasurer shall at each Annual General Meeting present a report on the business affairs of the Society. He shall also submit duly audited statements of income and expenditures and of assets and liabilities of the Society.

Section 3. Control and Investment

The Council shall have full control of the finances of the Society. All money received shall be incorporated into a banking account with such bank as may be decided upon. All withdrawals must be signed by the Treasurer and countersigned by the President or Vice-President and President Elect. The Council shall be empowered to

invest in such securities and on such terms as it shall decide appropriate, the entire or any portion of the accumulated funds which shall not be required for the immediate needs of the Society.

Section 4. The PSAS Trust Fund

A trust fund for PSAS shall be opened. The fund shall be derived from life membership dues and donations which shall be specified for the purposes.

Only interest earning of the trust fund can be used for operational purposes.

**ARTICLE IX
POWERS of the COUNCIL**

Section 1. The Council shall be the policy making body of the Society.

Section 2. Budgetary proposal made by the President at the start of the year shall be approved by the Council.

Section 3. It shall pass for approval all recommendations for appointments to the Ad Hoc Committee.

Section 4. The Council shall pass in review recommendations of the Ad Hoc Committee.

**ARTICLE X
DISTINGUISHED FELLOW AWARD**

Section 1. The recipient of this award shall be disqualified from any other standing awards. The award shall consist of a plaque and a medallion. There shall be no monetary award. The Council shall promulgate the qualification, criteria and guidelines for the award.

**ARTICLE XI
AMENDMENTS to the CONSTITUTION**

Section 1. Proposed Amendment

Any proposed amendment to the Constitution must be signed by at least three members and may be considered for adoption to any Annual General Meeting of the Philippine Society of Animal Science, provided that the notice of such proposed amendment shall be received by the Secretary twenty (20) days prior to the meeting and circulated by him to all members of the Society during the annual meeting. A majority, i.e. two thirds of the total number of votes cast shall be required for the adoption of any amendments to the constitution.

Section 2. Effectivity

Amendments shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

Amended and ratified during the 23rd, 24th and 30th Annual Meetings, November 20-21, 1986, November 19-20, 1987 and November 18-19, 1993 at the Philippine International Convention Center, Manila, PCARRD, Los Baños, Laguna and Manila Hotel, Manila, respectively.

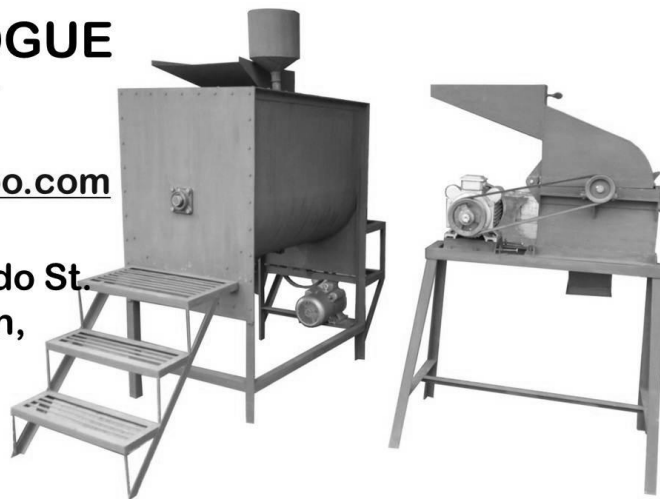

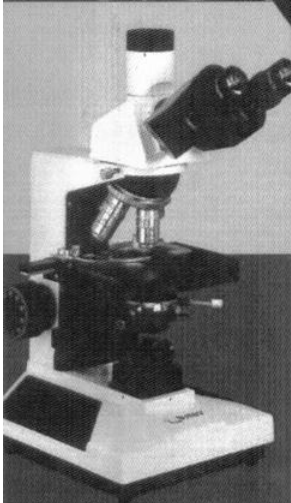

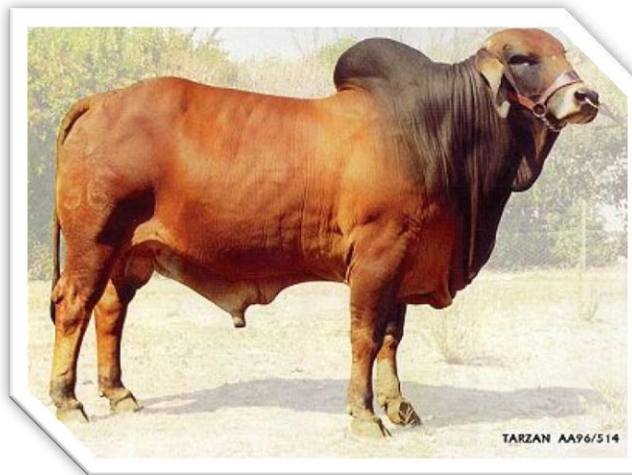
